There is a list of the buses that would change starting on page 5.



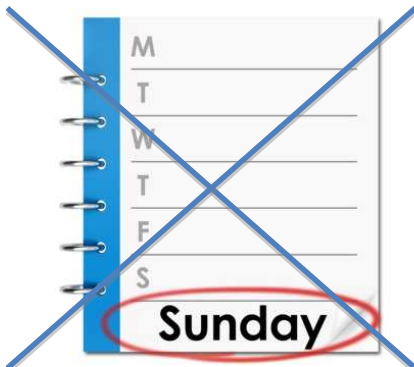
This will help us keep most of the buses and the buses people use the most.

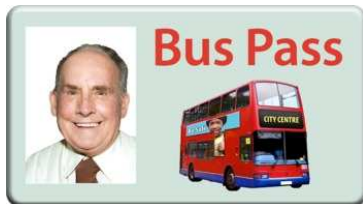
