Support worker

Nandnee joined the Watford Mencap children's centre on a week's work experience from Watford Grammar School for Girls. She continued as a volunteer and works every Friday evening, during school holidays and at other times if necessary.

The Watford Mencap children's centre is unique to the area and provides after school care for all children with learning disabilities regardless of their support needs. It has two playrooms, a soft-play area, sensory room and garden where children can play in safe, stimulating surroundings.

The children's centre also has a youth club, a Saturday club and play schemes during the school holidays. This provides a happy environment for the children and gives their carers a much-needed rest.
