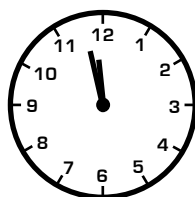

You have until 11.59pm on 26 April 2011 to apply for tickets.

The easiest way to apply for tickets is on the internet.



To apply for tickets on our website you need to have:

- An email address.



- A Visa debit, credit or prepaid card.



If you do not have a Visa card ask your bank to help you choose the right Visa card for you.

You need to register on our website to apply for tickets on the internet.

If you need support using the internet it's a good idea to ask someone to help you.



You can also apply for tickets by post.



To apply for tickets by post you will need an official ticketing guide and application form.

Some sports will happen over more than one day so you can choose which session to go to.

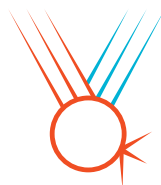
## You can apply for tickets for up to 20 sessions at the Olympic Games.

# Some sessions have special ticket prices for young people and older people.



We use this picture to show these sessions.

If you are aged 60 or over on 27 July 2012, tickets for these sessions will cost only £16.



Albert will be 81 so pays £16

If you are aged 16 or under on 27 July 2012, tickets for these sessions will cost the same as your age.



Emily will be 9 so pays £9



Jasmine will be 7 so pays £7



Dinesh will be 15 so pays £15



# Ticket prices in all 26 Olympic sports start from £20.

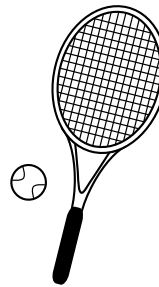


There are also higher priced tickets for each sport.

For every session you can choose the price and how many tickets you want to apply for.

Some sessions have a limit on how many tickets you can apply for.

## Make sure you have the best chance of getting tickets.

You can choose to have higher or lower priced tickets if you can't have the price you have chosen.



This gives you a better chance of getting tickets for the sports you choose.

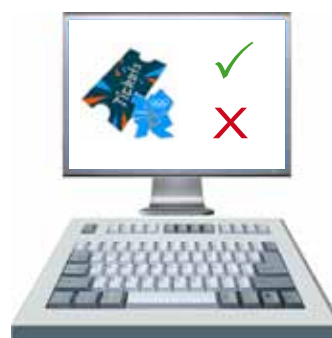


# We will tell you if you have got any tickets by 24 June 2011.



Lots of people might apply for tickets for some sessions. Not everyone will get tickets for these sessions.

We will choose who gets tickets by a random computer ballot - like a lottery.



## Paying for your tickets.

You will have given us your Visa card details on the internet or sent us a cheque or postal orders.



We will only take money from your Visa card, or cash your cheque or postal orders, between 10 May and 10 June 2011.

## Changing your mind.



If you decide you no longer want tickets or want to change the tickets you have applied for you can stop your application.

You can only do this between 15 March and 26 April 2011.



You will then have to apply again if you decide you still want tickets.
